## Basic Fire Fighter Course (BFFC)

Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University in collaboration with GMR Aero Academy

Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University (RGNAU), a Central University under the Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India. RGNAU offering 6-Month Residential Basic Fire Fighter Course (BFFC) in collaboration with GMR Aero Academy (GMRAA), an ICAO recognized Regional Training Centre of Excellence. The course is designed to prepare candidates for careers in Airport Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF), Industrial Fire Safety, Structural Fire Fighting, Emergency Response and Disaster Management Services.

Applications for admission to the 6-Month Residential Basic Fire Fighter Course (BFFC) for the Academic Session 2026 are invited from eligible and interested candidates. The details of the programme are as under:

### 2. About the Programme

The Basic Fire Fighter Course (BFFC) is a foundational professional training programme for entry-level fire service personnel. The programme provides theoretical knowledge, physical conditioning, rescue operations training, aircraft rescue and firefighting techniques, hazardous material handling and practical exposure to emergency response systems in aviation and industrial environments.

The course is aligned with relevant ICAO standards and operational requirements for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF).

### 3. Course Objectives

Upon successful completion of the course, trainees will be able to:

- Understand fundamentals of fire science, hydraulics and electricity.
- Operate firefighting equipment including hoses, pumps, extinguishers and breathing apparatus.
- Demonstrate firefighting drills, rescue operations and casualty handling.

- d. Understand airport emergency systems and ICAO regulations.
- e. Handle aircraft fire hazards, structural fires and industrial emergencies.
- f. Apply emergency response procedures and personal protective equipment (PPE).
- g. Understand hazardous material (HAZMAT) response procedures.
- h. Perform tactical and strategic rescue and firefighting operations.
- i. Develop discipline, physical endurance and operational readiness required in fire services.

#### **4. Course Content**

The programme broadly covers:

- ii. Fire Hydraulics, Pumps & Fire Appliances
- iii. Extinguishing Media & Firefighting Techniques
- iv. Emergency Procedures & Rescue Operations
- v. Breathing Apparatus & PPE Handling
- vi. Emergency Communication & Radio Telephony
- vii. Airport Layout & Airfield Familiarization
- viii. Aircraft Rescue & Fire Fighting (ARFF)
- ix. Hazardous Materials (HAZMAT)
- x. Emergency Medical Response
- xi. Physical Training, Squad Drill & Discipline
- xii. Live Fire Drills & Practical Firefighting Exercises
- xiii. On-the-Job Training (OJT) at IGRUA Fire Station
- xiv. Optional ICAO STP Certification Courses (Subject to applicable additional charges)
- xv. Building Fire Emergencies- First Responder
- xvi. HAZMAT First Responder (Operations Level)

#### **5. Eligibility Criteria**

##### **(A) Educational Qualification**

- i. 10+2 / Intermediate / equivalent examination from a recognized Board.
- ii. Candidates awaiting Class XII results may also apply, subject to submission of proof before commencement of training.
- iii. Candidates must be able to read, write, speak and understand instructions in Hindi and English.

**(B) Age Limit:** Candidates should be between 18 to 24 years as on the last date of application.

##### **(C) Driving License**

- i. Candidate should possess a valid LMV Driving License or valid LMV Learner's License.
- ii. Candidates without a permanent LMV License must submit a valid Learner's License before commencement of the course.

## 7. Medical Fitness Requirements

Candidates must undergo medical examination from a Government Hospital and submit a fitness certificate at the time of admission. Indicative medical tests include:

- i. Haemoglobin, RBC, WBC, ESR
- ii. Blood Sugar (FBS/PPBS)
- iii. Lipid Profile
- iv. ECG / Stress Test
- v. Chest X-Ray
- vi. Urine Examination
- vii. Colour Blindness & Night Blindness Tests
- viii. Ultrasonography (Whole Abdomen)
- ix. Flat Foot / Knock Knee Examination
- x. Other general medical examinations as prescribed
- xi. Medically unfit candidates shall not be admitted.

## 8. Selection Process

Selection of candidates shall be done in following manner:

- i. Scrutiny of applications
- ii. Physical Fitness / Physical Efficiency Test (PET)
- iii. Medical Fitness Examination
- iv. Personal Interaction / Interview (if required)

Mere fulfilment of minimum eligibility criteria does not guarantee admission.

## 9. Course Fee

Course Fee : ₹3,00,000/- + applicable taxes

**Fee includes the following-**

- i. Hostel accommodation
- ii. Food/Mess facilities
- iii. Local transportation during training
- iv. Training material and standard facilities required for the course

**Fee Payment Schedule**

- i. First Instalment: Before commencement of training
- ii. Second Instalment: After completion of 03 months of training

**10. Residential Facility**

The programme is fully residential. Boarding, lodging, physical training facilities and practical training infrastructure shall be provided at RGNAU Campus, Fursatganj, Amethi (U.P.). Practical ARFF exposure and OJT shall also be conducted in coordination with IGRUA facilities as per programme requirements.
