BMS in Aviation Services & Air Cargo

The Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University (RGNAU) was established by an Act of Parliament- the Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University Act, 2013- as India's first Central University dedicated exclusively to Aviation and Allied Disciplines. In pursuance of its statutory mandate to develop skilled human resources for the rapidly expanding aviation ecosystem, RGNAU has established School of Management to offer specialized Postgraduate and Undergraduate Management Programmes.

The BMS in Aviation Services & Air Cargo is a three-year undergraduate programme offered in accordance with the RGNAU Ordinances and Academic Regulations. The programme is designed to develop skilled professionals for the rapidly growing aviation services and air cargo sectors. The curriculum provides a strong foundation in management along with specialized knowledge of airport ground services, cargo operations, logistics management, aviation regulations, safety procedures, and customer service. It combines theoretical learning with practical exposure through case studies, industry interaction, project work, and 1-year industry sponsored apprenticeship, preparing graduates for diverse roles in airlines, airports, cargo terminals, and logistics companies.

The University invites applications from eligible candidates for admission to Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS) in Aviation Services & Air Cargo for the Academic Session 2026-27:

Eligibility Criteria

- a. Candidates must have passed 10+2 with any stream from a recognized Board with a minimum 50% marks in aggregate.

Relaxation:

- a. A relaxation of 5% marks shall be applicable for candidates belonging to SC/ST categories, as per Government of India norms.

Age Limit:

- a. Maximum 21 year as on July 31, 2026.

Admission Process

- a. Admission through CUET-UG Score/ Exam conducted by the RGNAU.
- b. The final admission shall be strictly based on merit, reservation policy, and eligibility criteria as prescribed by the University.

Reservation Policy

- a. Reservation of seats shall be implemented in accordance with Government of India norms, applicable to SC / ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS/PwD.

- b. Candidates must produce valid certificates issued by the competent authority at the time of admission.

Application Procedure

- a. CUET-UG score holder and other candidates may apply online through the Samarth Admission Portal of RGNAU.

Counselling Services at RGNAU

- a. The University has engaged a qualified Counsellor (including dedicated support for female students) to provide counselling services aimed at supporting students' mental well-being, emotional resilience, stress management, and personal development. Students may seek guidance on academic stress, adjustment concerns, interpersonal issues, and other personal challenges in a confidential and supportive environment.
- b. Counselling support is also available to assist students in settling into a new academic and social environment, particularly during the transition to university life. This includes support for adaptation to campus life, hostel adjustment, peer interaction, time management, and coping with the demands of a new learning environment.
- c. The University facilitates psychological and aptitude mapping, where appropriate, to help students better understand their strengths, interests, and potential, and to provide informed guidance for career planning, academic progression, and personal growth. Such support is intended to help students make well-informed choices aligned with their capabilities and aspirations.
- d. Through its counselling services, the University seeks to promote a supportive, inclusive, and student-centric environment that contributes to students' overall well-being, academic success, and holistic development.

Training & Placement Support

- a. The University has established a Career Development Cell (CDC) under the Chairmanship of a Senior Faculty Member to facilitate training, internship, skill development, industry interface, and placement support for students. The Cell works towards enhancing students' employability through career counselling, aptitude and soft skills training, industry interactions, expert sessions, internship facilitation, and

placement assistance in collaboration with industry, government organizations, and other prospective employers.

- b. So far three batches of BMS have graduated and placed in various Aviation companies in India and abroad. Further to that, University arranges paid apprenticeship for all BMS students in their 3rd year of study.

Student Admission & Reporting Guidelines

1. Fee Refund Policy

- Withdrawal requests must be submitted through the prescribed online/offline mode.
- Full refund (100%) of fees shall be made if withdrawal is requested within the stipulated period before commencement of classes, after deduction of processing charges (as per UGC guidelines).
- If withdrawal is made after commencement of classes, refund shall be made on a pro-rata basis, depending on:
 - Number of days attended
 - Academic calendar schedule
- No refund shall be admissible after a specified cut-off date notified by the University.
- Caution Money/Security Deposit shall be refunded after adjustment of dues.
- Refunds shall be processed only through bank transfer within the prescribed timeline.
- The University reserves the right to revise refund rules in accordance with UGC/AICTE notifications issued from time to time.

Refund after Cut-off Date

Timeline of Withdrawal	Refund Amount
≥ 15 days before last date of admission	100% refund (Only a deduction of Rs. 1000.00 as Processing Fee)
< 15 days before last date	90% refund
≤ 15 days after last date	80% refund
15-30 days after last date	50% refund
> 30 days after last date	No refund

2. Withdrawal of Admission

- A student may withdraw admission by submitting a formal application to the Admission Cell duly forwarded by the Head/ Coordinator of the Department.
- Withdrawal must be accompanied by:
 - Fee receipt
 - Admission letter
 - Bank details for refund
- Withdrawal shall be effective from the date of submission/approval.
- Academic registration shall stand cancelled automatically upon withdrawal.
- Refund, if any, shall be governed by the Fee Refund Policy.
- Students shall be issued withdrawal/ relieving certificate upon completion of formalities.

3. Cancellation of Admission

Admission may be cancelled by the University under the following circumstances:

- Submission of false/forged documents or incorrect information
- Failure to meet eligibility criteria
- Non-payment of fees within stipulated time
- Failure to report physically within notified dates
- Violation of University rules, discipline, or anti-ragging regulations
- Non-compliance with medical fitness requirements, if applicable

Consequences:

- Admission shall be cancelled without notice
- Fees may be forfeited (fully or partially) as per rules
- Legal/disciplinary action may be initiated, where applicable

4. Documents to be Produced at the Time of Reporting at RGNAU

Candidates must bring original documents along with two sets of self-attested photocopies:

- Admission Offer Letter
- Fee Payment Receipt
- All Academic Certificates & Mark Sheets (Original)
- Transfer Certificate (TC)/School Leaving Certificate
- Migration Certificate
- Character Certificate
- Category Certificate (in prescribed format, if applicable)
- Income Certificate (for EWS/OBC-NCL, if applicable)
- Medical Fitness Certificate
- Anti-Ragging Affidavit (Student & Parent)
- Valid Photo ID Proof
- Passport size photographs (6-8 copies)

Failure to produce original documents may lead to cancellation of admission.

5. Goods/Items to be Brought at the Time of Reporting

Students are advised to bring:

- Bedding (bedsheet, pillow, blanket)

- Electrical appliances may be regulated as per Hostel Rules
- Prohibited items (as notified) are not allowed in campus/hostels

6. Education Loan

- RGNAU is recognized for the purpose of education loans by nationalized/private banks.
- Students may apply under:
 - Vidya Lakshmi Portal
 - Respective bank schemes
- Required documents:
 - Admission letter
 - Fee structure
 - Academic records
- The University may provide:
 - Bonafide certificate
 - Fee certificate
- Loan approval is subject to bank policies and eligibility criteria.

7. Anti-Ragging Form (Mandatory Compliance)

(As per UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging, 2009)

- Submission of Anti-Ragging Affidavit by:
 - Student
 - Parent/Guardian
- Affidavit must be submitted through:
 - Online portal (**www.antiragging.in**) or
 - Prescribed format at the time of reporting
- Ragging in any form is a punishable offence, including:
 - Suspension
 - Expulsion
 - FIR/legal action
- RGNAU maintains zero tolerance towards ragging
