About University

The Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University (RGNAU) has been established by an Act of Parliament called the Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University Act, 2013 at Fursatganj, Dist. Amethi, Uttar Pradesh. The university has been envisaged as the premier institution of higher learning within the aviation milieu aimed at providing cutting edge and critical research to enhance the aviation industry in India.

The Act of Parliament empowers the university to award Diploma, Degree, and Post Graduate Degrees in the field of civil aviation. At the same time collaborations with the leading international universities/ institutions in the aviation domain, are being forged towards proffering global knowledge that is customized to local requirements.

Objectives of the University

- 1. How to reach RGNAU

Fursatganj, Amethi are known world over for two landmarks, namely the Air Field and the Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University more commonly known as RGNAU. Situated about 80 km west of Lucknow Airport, RGNAU is well connected to Lucknow by Road and Air. Fursatganj can be reached in about 10 km by road from Raebareli Railway Station by private taxi, autorickshaw can be rented to reach the University. INSTRUCTION TO 1ST YEAR STUDENTS:

Registration process:

- i. All students who are to be admitted to RGNAU must submit the JOSSA/CSAB/University offer letter and photo copies of original documents mentioned on **CHECK LIST** before the Physical Registration process.
- ii. On the day of admission, the student should report to the designated registration desk and produce their original documents for verification. Once registration is completed, you are advised to meet faculty advisor to the respective Department.
- iii. Fee structure of the newly admitted UG student is as mentioned in Table below. The balance of admission fee shall be payable on or before registration.

Documents to be produced at the time of Registration (as per CHECK LIST):

All 1st Year UG & PG students who are to be admitted to Rajiv Gandhi National Aviation University (RGNAU) must require following before reporting for the Physical Registration Process.

- 6. I understand that as per rules and resolution of the University, I will not be permitted to possess or use any motorized vehicle inside the University campus, unless I am permitted to do so by a written authorization from the Competent Authority.
- 7. I also declare that I am not suffering from any serious/contagious ailment including psychology related symptoms.

Code of Conduct and Discipline:

- 1. Students shall conduct themselves within and outside the precincts of the University in a manner befitting the students of an institution of national importance.
- 2. Students shall show due respect to the teachers of the University, the Wardens of the Halls of Residence and the Officers of University proper courtesy and consideration should be extended to the employees of the University and of the Hall of Residence. ANTI-RAGGING CAMPUS & HOSTEL: PUNISHMENT

Punishment Provisions:

Any student or group of students found guilty of ragging on campus or off campus shall be liable to one or more of the following punishments:

- Debarring from appearing in any sessional test/university examination or withholding results
- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges
- Withdrawing scholarships and other benefits
- Suspension from the University for a period of one or more month
- Cancellation of admission
- Debarring from representing the University in any national or international meet tournament youth festival etc
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel
- Rustication from the University for periods varying from 1 to 4 semesters or equivalent period
- Expulsion from the University and consequent debarring from admission to any other University/Institution
- Fine up to twenty-five thousand rupees
- Imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees or with both
- Collective punishment when the students committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the
 University shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential
 raggers.
